

WHAT TO DO AFTER A CRASH

1. If anyone is injured, call 911 immediately.

Report the crash to law enforcement and obtain the crash report details from the officer.

2. Document the Scene (If Safe to Do So)

- Take photos and videos of the vehicles, road conditions, and surroundings.
- Secure any footage from dash cams, GoPros, or similar devices.

3. Exchange Information

- Take clear photos of:
 - Driver's licenses or IDs
 - License plates
 - Insurance cards
- Gather names and contact details of any witnesses.

4. Prioritize Your Health

Even if you don't feel injured right away, seek medical evaluation to ensure your well-being. Options include:

- Ambulance transport if needed
- Emergency room care
- A visit to your primary care physician or a specialist

5. Protect Your Rights

Reach out for legal advice as soon as possible—no matter how minor the accident may seem. We're here to guide you.
